- Fire extinguishers

- Syringes
- Solvents and turpentine
- Sealed drums
- RV fridges
- Household liquids (vegetable oil)
- Flourescent lamps
- PCB ballasts
- Oily rags

## Putting Waste In Its Place

**Roseridge Landfill**  
for Secure Non-hazardous Waste

## Roseridge Landfill Fees

The Roseridge Waste Management Services Commission was established in May 2001 and its member municipalities are Sturgeon County, the towns of Bon Accord, Gibbons, Legal, Morinville and Redwater.

Regular garbage pickup is available for the five towns within Sturgeon County's boundaries. Town residents can haul their excess debris to the Roseridge Landfill.

Landfill permits for town residents must be picked up at the respective Town Office prior to going to the landfill.

### Town of Legal Permit Fees

- Landfill permits for Town of Legal residents must be picked up at the Town Office (5021 50 St) prior to going to the landfill
- Permit is \$5.00 per calendar year (January to December)
- All weight in excess of the 1000 kg annual limit is charged \$34.00 per 1000 kg and is charged on the January utility bill as "Landfill Overage" charge

## Site Rules and Regulations

Disposing of waste in a proper manner

- reduces contamination
- provides a neat and clean facility
- minimizes the risk of accidental injury

Dumping trash, household chemicals and other toxic materials is illegal and it's unsightly! Not only does it pose a risk to the environment, it is also harmful to humans.

- **A valid permit must be displayed upon entry to the site**
- **Landfill permits may be revoked at any time**
- **Permits are non-transferable**
- **Scavenging is strictly prohibited**
- **Children and pets must remain in the vehicle at all times**
- **Waste must be deposited in accordance with the directions of landfill staff**
- **All loads entering the site are subject to inspection for unacceptable materials**
- **Smoking is prohibited**
- **All loads must be covered or secure**
- **Only waste suitable for Class II landfill will be accepted**
- **Commission staff have the right to reject loads**
- **Segregation of recyclables is encouraged**

*Site users agree to indemnify and hold the Commission harmless from all liability resulting from the use of the landfill.*

*Littering and improper disposal are fineable offences.*

## Common Household Items Accepted

- Corrugated cardboard
- Newspapers
- Plastic milk jugs
- Chemical containers (*providing they meet the standards set by Alberta Environment which requires that the container has been punctured and has been triple rinsed*)
- Oil filters/jugs/non-contaminated oil
- Batteries
- Tires
- Renovation material (i.e. old carpets, drywall, bathroom fixtures)
- Household appliances
- Freon type of appliances (i.e. fridge, freezer, water cooler) \$20 charge

## Unacceptable Household Items

- Commercial demolition
- Auto bodies & scrap metals
- Concrete

Please report any mixed loads to the scale operators to be directed to the appropriate dumping areas.
