

BY-LAW No 22

A By-Law for the purpose of establishing a Fire Department, appointing the officers thereof, regulating and providing their remuneration and prescribing their duties, and providing protection from fire by the purchase of chemical engines and equipment and the building of necessary housings.

Under and by virtue of the authority vested in the Village of Legal by Section 95 of the Village Act, Chapter 54, Statutes of Alberta, 1927, the Council enacts as follows:

1. That a Fire Department be established within the Village of Legal and provide such necessary equipment as the Council may determine for protection from fire.
2. That the following officers be appointed: One (1) Fire Chief who shall also be constable and who shall drill the Fire Men sufficiently for effective work in case of fire and have supervision over same. Twelve (12) Fire Men who shall carry out all duties assigned to them in their respective capacities as Fire Men.
3. That such Fire Men shall obey to orders of the Fire Chief and their remuneration shall be fixed by resolution of the Council from time to time.

This BY-LAW shall come into force immediately after the date of the passing thereof.
