

Information for Voters

To vote in the 2025 municipal election in Legal, you must be:

- At least 18 years of age;
- A Canadian citizen;
- A resident of the Town of Legal; and,
- A resident in Legal for six consecutive months prior to Oct. 20.

Voter Identification

At the voting station, voters must provide identification that proves your identity and current residence. Any of the of the following documents with the voter's name and address will be accepted:

- Identification issued by a Canadian government or agency of that government that contains a photograph of the elector and their name and current address.
- Bank or credit card statement or personal cheque.
- Government cheque or cheque stub.
- Income or property tax assessment notice.
- Insurance policy or coverage card.
- Letter from a public curator, public guardian or public trustee.
- Pension plan statement of benefits, contributions or participation.
- Residential lease or mortgage statement.
- Statement of government benefits (e.g., employee insurance, old-age security, social assistance, disability support, child tax benefit).
- Utility bill (e.g., telephone, hydro, gas or water).
- Vehicle ownership, registration or insurance certificate.

A letter or form confirming a person lives at a stated address will also be accepted. The letter can be signed prior to the vote by an authorized representative of the following:

- Commercial property management company
- Correctional institution

- First Nations band or reserve
- Post-secondary institution
- Facility that provides services to the unhoused
- Supportive living facility or treatment centre

If a voter's identification shows a post office box number as the address instead of a residential or legal address, it can be accepted as verification of their current address if it is a reasonable distance to the voting jurisdiction.

Advance Voting Stations

Election day is Oct. 20 but eligible voters are encouraged to vote early. Advance voting date and location will be announced at a later date.
